Southside Facilities Replacement Environmental Assessment

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

Hampton Roads Transit, with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) as lead Federal agency, has published an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Southside Facilities Replacement Project.

The EA evaluates the environmental effects of replacement transit maintenance and administrative facilities in the City of Norfolk. The EA is currently available for public review and comment at Hampton Roads Transit Southside Administrative Building (1500 Monticello Avenue, Norfolk), Hampton Roads Transit Headquarters (3400 Victoria Blvd, Hampton), City of Norfolk Planning Department (801 East Main Street, Norfolk), Norfolk Public Library Main Branch (235 East Plume Street, Norfolk), and the Norfolk Public Library Blyden Branch (879 East Princess Anne Rd). The EA is also available in electronic form at www.gohrtransit.org. The deadline to submit comments is June 10, 2009.
